

## Water Bottle Filling Stations Installed Across Leeds and Grenville

*Healthy Kids Community Challenge Leeds and Grenville is working with local organizations to encourage children and families to drink water*



Healthy Kids Community Challenge Leeds and Grenville is pleased to announce the installation of new water bottle filling stations in partnership with 23 charitable and non-profit organizations/groups across the region. This initiative is designed to engage communities around the second theme of the Healthy Kids Community Challenge: **Water Does Wonders**.

In support of the Water Does Wonders theme, which encourages kids and families to drink water as a healthy alternative to sugar-sweetened beverages, Healthy Kids Community Challenge Leeds and Grenville introduced the Community Water Bottle Filling Station Initiative. Water Bottle Filling Stations provide access to fast, clean, hands-free water.

“We are thrilled to see so many Water Bottle Filling Stations being installed across our community”, says Joanne Desormeaux, Healthy Kids Community Challenge Facilitator in Leeds and Grenville. “Water is essential for good health and these stations will provide a simple, convenient, and low-cost option for children and families to quench their thirst,” says Desormeaux.

*\*Water Bottle Filling Stations located in schools are for student and staff use only during regular school hours. Public who use school facilities for Community Use outside of regular school hours may access stations with required permissions.*
